GPs Fees from 1 April 2026

Your appointment fee varies based on the type and length of the appointment. If you have a Medicare card, Medicare will refund you part of the fee (Medicare Rebate).

Care Plans/Health Assessments

These will continue to be bulk billed.

Procedures – These costs may, in some cases, be charged in addition to other item numbers.

- Iron Infusions - \$250 (rebate of \$84.90)
- Implanon In/Out - \$15 (non rebateable)
- Ear Syringes - \$15 (per ear non rebateable)
- Excisions - \$50 (non rebateable)
- Biopsies - \$15 (non rebateable)
- Steroid Injection - \$20 (non rebateable)
- Wedge Resections - \$50 (non rebateable)

Consumables

Consumable items used during your consult visit may be charged separately, with fee's typically ranging from \$5 - \$50, depending on the type and quantity.
